Dear Health Center Supporter,

Our commitment to the community to provide accessible, quality health care spans more than 50 years. As we enter the next decade of service, we are excited to share our impact report for 2021. In response to the pandemic, the health center worked to provide COVID-19 testing and vaccines while maintaining our commitment for accessible medical and dental care. Last year, we served more than 3,400 patients, provided more than 3,200 COVID-19 tests and 3,000 vaccine doses.

In 2022, we are looking to the future with project plans underway to better serve our patients and the communities that we serve:

- The Sto-Rox Family Health Center will undergo renovations in early fall to expand our capacity for patient care. Three new dual-purposed patient care rooms for medical and behavioral health services, updated dental suites, patient registration and waiting areas will create warm and welcoming spaces for our patients.
- A new mobile health unit will provide on-site primary care including medical visits, vaccinations, and COVID testing. The mobile unit expands our outreach into communities and supports partnerships to connect individuals who need medical services.

We are grateful for the support of partners and donors who make the work of our health centers possible. Thank you! We are so excited to further the mission of Sto-Rox Neighborhood Health Council in this next decade of service.
